- _____ Complete the MDCC Admissions Requirements by logging in or creating a MDCC MyDelta account and submit your online MDCC school admission/readmission application. Link to admissions (<https://www.msdelta.edu/admissions/index.php>)
- _____ On the Health Care Assistant Program website page (located under Health Sciences) apply to the program. Direct link to the HCA application page (<https://www.msdelta.edu/programs/health-sciences/health-care-assistant/apply.php>). **Read all Sections on this webpage** (Minimum Admission Requirements, Directions to Apply, Selection, Student Responsibilities, Progression, Policy on Readmission to Health Science Programs, and Program Cost)
- _____ E-Script or mail all official transcripts (including High School) to the MDCC Office of Admissions. All transcripts must be on file by May 16 for summer applications, July 31 for fall applications, and November 30 for spring applications.
- _____ If applicable submit ACT scores to the MDCC Office of Admissions. No minimum score is required
- _____ If no ACT score send Accuplacer score to pmcgee@msdelta.edu or schedule an Accuplacer test administered at MDCC: instructions are found under "Minimum Admission Requirements". No minimum score is required
- _____ Review the online mandatory Health Sciences policies found on the main Health Science webpage under Program Policies – direct link is below <https://www.msdelta.edu/programs/health-sciences/program-policies/admission-policy.php>
